Recruitment fraud is a serious issue in the job market. It may involve offering fictitious job opportunities, requesting personal information and payment requests to process false applications. This fraud is a global concern that PAE takes seriously.

Recruitment fraud normally occurs online from sites that don't belong to or are not associated with PAE. It can also occur via emails requesting recipients provide personal information to process false applications.

Official communications about employment opportunities will always come from a registered email address ending in @pae.com.

Please contact jobs@pae.com if you question the legitimacy of the offer.

There are several ways to identify and prevent recruiting fraud. Warning signs include:

- Requests for personal information
- Requests for information about other companies or individuals
- Offer to pay a percentage of the fees requested if the candidate pays to process the application
- Overwhelming sense of urgency for the applicant to act immediately

If you think you're the target of recruitment fraud:

- Don't respond to the solicitor
- Don't send money or provide private information
- Save the email message
- Contact jobs@pae.com if you question the legitimacy of the offer
- Contact your local law enforcement agency to report if found fraudulent
